



System Information:

- 1. All monthly bacteriological samples returned an absence for coliform bacteria for the month of February 2017.
- 2. There was one water leak reported for the month of February 2017 which occurred Friday night the 17th. A six-inch line had been severed in the cuddy creek. Storm runoff was the reason for the line break. Operators, and Santana's pumping were able to repair the line and bring the system back up to pressure at 10-10:30 am Saturday the 18th. An estimated 224,000 gallons of storage helped contribute to the 20 percent water loss for the month of February.
- 3. Attached is a proposal for replacing a worn, and defective 700-P2 motor saver on our Chimney Cyn Well. This motor saver gave out over the last rain storm. It is undetermined if the weather affected the motor saver, for the electrical panel is water tight. "See attached proposal"
- 4. The two front tires on the backhoe have been replaced with new rubber, and foam filled at cost of \$1112.04. The existing tires were worn, with the left existing tire unable to hold air. These new tires should last many years to come, without the worries of inconvenient flats when at standby, or when in service.
- 5. Attached is an example of some basic welding safety training, it seems certification is more involved.
- 6. A new battery was purchased and installed into the Chevy.




