General Policies: Water bills not paid in full by the 20th day of the month are considered delinquent and a penalty of 10% of the outstanding amount due shall be added. Any water bill not paid within 60 days will constitute cause to discontinue water service. Rates to reinstate service are defined in Appendix B.

The customer changeover charge, as defined in Appendix B, will be included on the first month's billing if not paid out of escrow.

Customer is responsible for keeping current contact information available to the Water Board office. Failure to do so could result in the service being disconnected.

For applicants applying for a new Commercial water line installation or a will serve letter (no meter or connection previously installed), a meter fee will be required. The fee will be determined by the size meter requested by applicant. The applicant will also be responsible for any construction costs or additional pipeline needed to accommodate said meter installation. All will serve requests will be assessed the appropriate charge according to the Districts "Development Rate Plan."

The District owns and maintains all pipelines up to and including a customer's water meter. Property owners are responsible for the installation of waterline connections from the meter to said property. All connections and pipelines installed on customer's side of the meter remain the property of the customer and the responsibility of the customer to maintain. LCWD reserves the right to access all systems lines and meters and is granted easements to all such systems.

It is the District policy that water pressure regulators be installed and maintained by the property owner on the incoming waterline and the LCWD is not responsible for such regulators or pressure problems.

LCWD reserves the right to shut off all meters, without notice, where a situation occurs that puts the LCWD water system or customers in immediate danger or causes a loss of water to the District.
