**CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE**  
FOR  
CUSTOMERS IN THE STATE ZONE  
LEBEC COUNTY WATER DISTRICT (#1510051)

On January 29, 2019, customers in the State Zone of the Lebec County Water District were notified to boil the tap water or use bottled water for drinking or cooking purposes. The boil water notice was issued due to a broken water main that we noticed around 12pm on that day. The State Zone was shut down in order to repair the broken water main. The broken water main was repaired, and water service was restored at 6 pm in the evening on the same day.

Following completion of the repairs and restoration of pressure, the impacted portion of the distribution system was disinfected and flushed, under the supervision of a certified water distribution operator. A total of four (4) bacteriological quality samples were subsequently collected on January 29, 2019, from representative locations in the distribution system. All four (4) samples tested negative for total coliform bacteria. The Lebec County Water District, in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water has determined that the tap water in the State Zone is now considered safe to drink. **It is no longer necessary to boil the tap water or consume bottled water.**
