## **CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE**

FOR CUSTOMERS LOCATED IN THE LEBEC ZONE LEBEC COUNTY WATER DISTRICT (#1510051)

On <u>August 27, 2020</u>, customers in the Lebec Zone (Circle Drive, Canyon Drive, South Drive, North Drive, Karr Drive) of Lebec County Water District were notified to boil the tap water or use bottled water for drinking or cooking purposes. The boil water notice was issued due to a leak repair in the Lebec Zone. The Lebec Zone was shut down in order to complete the repair. The leak was repaired, and water was restored by 11:30pm on the same day.

Following completion of the repair and restoration of pressure, the impacted portion of the distribution system was disinfected and flushed, under the supervision of a certified water distribution operator. A total of three (3) bacteriological quality samples were subsequently collected on August 27, 2020 from representative locations in the distribution system. All three (3) samples tested negative for total coliform bacteria. The Lebec County Water District, in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water has determined that the tap water in the Lebec Zone is now considered safe to drink. It is no longer necessary to boil the tap water or consume bottled water.
